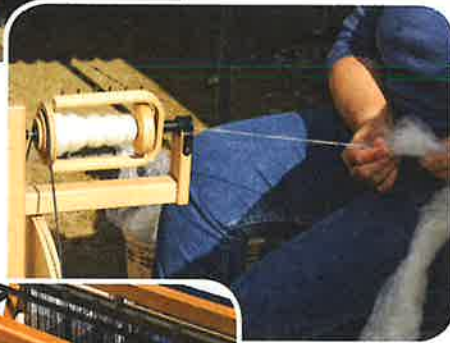

From Sheep to Sweaters

Tabitha made clothing out of wool. Everything was made by hand. Wool comes from sheep. Today we use machines to make wool into fabric. Some people use wool yarn to knit sweaters and other warm things to wear.



1. The sheep's wool is cut off.
2. The wool is combed to remove straw and burs.
3. The wool is washed.



4. The wool is spun into yarn.



5. The yarn is woven into cloth or knit for clothing.
